


When you don't know how to say it

- Say it anyway – your grammar doesn't have to be perfect.
- Describe or explain what you mean. If you can't remember the word *vet*, say *the animal doctor*.
- Explain with words that mean the opposite. Say *not kind* if you have forgotten the word *nasty*.
- Use synonyms. Say *beginning* if you have forgotten the word *introduction*.
- Listen to the people you are speaking to and use words they have used.
- Ask for help from the person you are speaking to.
- Use body language to communicate.
- Start your sentence again, in a different way, if you are stuck.
- Guess how to say new words if you don't know.
- Plan out in advance what you want to say, unless it is spontaneous speech.
